The Holiday Shows will be held December 8th at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

Tickets for our performance at the Cumberland Valley High School Performing Arts Center are on sale now in the studio office, during regular office hours. Tickets are \$5.00 if purchased before show day. The tickets will be \$8.00 at the door the day of the performances. Cash or check only will be accepted for tickets.

Dancers must use the White Ticket Provided with the Seating Chart.

Everyone using a seat must have a ticket. This includes toddlers. Children under 3 may sit on a parent's lap at no charge, but you must purchase a ticket if you want your toddler to have a dedicated seat. As always, a portion of the ticket proceeds will go to charity.

Please purchase tickets in advance when possible to avoid confusion at the shows, and only purchase tickets you know you will need, as all show tickets are non-refundable.

- Closings will **not** be announced on TV, radio, or the Studio '91 website.

June Show Costumes

- Miss Janice orders costumes early, during the manufacturer's discounted price period, and passes those savings on to our dance families. This means, however, that costumes for the June Show must be ordered in December. **Therefore, all costume payments must be in the office before the studio closes on Dec. 15th.**
- Dancer's tights and finale T-shirt costs are included in the total costume cost. Sample T-shirt sizes will be available in the upstairs waiting room.
- **During December Open House week (Dec. 10th - 15th), a parent or guardian must be present to sign his or her agreement and confirm the costume size to be ordered.** A manufacturer's size chart will be available for reference.

Please try on last year's costume and note the size. This will help you determine the best size for this year's costume.

- Costumes will **not** be ordered without a parent's signature and full payment by Dec. 15th. Cash, check or Credit card (*Visa, Master Charge, Discover*) will be accepted for costumes. Dancers may not perform without a costume.

As stated in the welcome booklet received at registration, and the specialty class information received in May, students in Extra Tap, Extra Jazz and Special Ballet classes will incur fees for extra costumes. There will also be an additional guest choreographer's fee for Extra Tap and Extra Jazz classes.



Lost & Found

Please remember to frequently check the lost and found box in the waiting room at the bottom of the stairs. Items currently in the box will be discarded monthly. If you have lost smaller items, such as jewelry or glasses, check the bulletin board in the upstairs waiting room.



Open House

Open house week will be held on December 10th –15th for all combination classes and specialty classes. If you attend Open House sessions, please show the instructors your utmost respect and give the dancers 100% of your attention by not talking or causing other distractions during class. Your enthusiasm and attentiveness will be appreciated by your dancers and our instructors. Feel free to photograph and videotape, but for the safety of our dancers, please do not use Studio '91 receptacles to connect power cords to your equipment. Relief schedule is attached to the newsletter. *Please note that there is a limit of two guests per dancer.*

Dress Code Reminders

As stated in our policies and procedures booklet distributed at registration:

- All combination class dancers are required to wear ballet pink or white tights
- Special ballet class dancers are required to wear ballet pink tights
- Tan tights may only be worn in Extra Jazz or Extra Tap specialty classes

Tights are available for purchase at Pirouettes if your dancer does not have the correct color.

- If you plan to purchase holiday gift items for your dancer, please be sure they meet studio dress code requirements (i.e. sheer skirts, specific jazz shorts/pants). All items sold at Pirouettes meet studio dress codes.
- Be sure to label all new holiday dancewear with the student's name.
- Turtlenecks may be worn under leotards for extra warmth in the winter.
