For the Show...

Please make sure the person bringing the dancer to the dressing room for rehearsals and the shows, **knows the dancer's combination class time and dressing room assignment.** The dressing room assignments are listed on the "Everything You Need to Know About the Show" packet. Thanks for your help!



Wristbands

Dress Rehearsal:

At Dress Rehearsal one wristband will be given to a parent of each dancer. This wristband will be your admission into the auditorium to take pictures and videotape during the rehearsal. If you are helping back stage during the rehearsal, you may give the wristband to a relative or friend who is going to take pictures and videotape in your place. (Please remember professional videos from the day of the June Show are available for purchase.)

Show Day:

As stated in the "Dressing Room Guidelines," a mother/guardian who brings the dancer to her/his dressing room will receive a backstage wristband. The backstage wristband is your pass back stage to pick up your dancer after the performance. This is done to ensure the safety of all of the dancers. If you have a dancer in 5th grade and above you may choose to give the wristband to the dancer. This will allow the dancer to be dismissed to the lobby by dressing room moms when they are ready.

- **August 24th**– The 2007-2008 dance season begins!

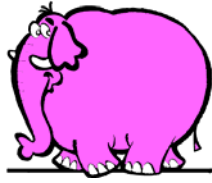


Dressing Room Mom Information
