urday March 27th

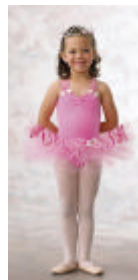

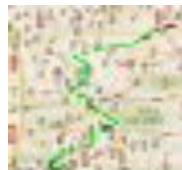
Costume Delivery

Photo Week

Photo sessions are scheduled for **April 12 –April 17th at the studio**. Please make sure you check the photo schedule listed on the photo envelope to be received at open house to find your dancer's photo time. There is no need to make up these classes, as your photo time is considered your class time. **Please do not wear costumes to the studio**. All costumes should be brought to the studio in some type of protective plastic or garment bag.



Please make sure all costumes, tights, headpieces, props, and shoes are labeled with your dancer's name or initials prior to your photo date. If you have purchased new ballet slippers that need to be sewn, please have that done for photos. Even if you do not plan to purchase individual photos, please plan to attend class photo times in order to be in the group picture. (Group photos will be available for purchase and will be printed in the Keepsake Program.) **Moms, you must stay to dress dancers for photos; do not drop them off alone during photo week.**

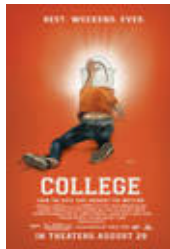
Partnering Class
