Since temperatures are dropping, we wanted to take this opportunity to remind you that dancers may wear turtle-necks under their leotards for extra warmth.

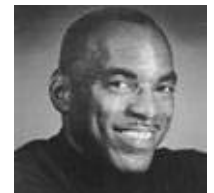

Holiday Performances "The Land of Sweet Dances"

- The Holiday Shows to be held December 8th at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. are for dancers in all combination classes to perform a dance to a candy themed song. Performances are approximately 45 minutes long. All students are welcome to perform. (Please notify Miss Janice if your dancer is **NOT** planning to participate in the Holiday Show. Your dancer should still attend classes even if he or she is not participating.) Please see the class list for which show your dancer is in. (Information was sent with your October Newsletter.)
- Tickets are on sale in the studio office, during regular office hours, beginning November 1st. Tickets are \$5.00 if purchased before show. The tickets will be \$8.00 at the door the day of the performances. Cash or check only will be accepted for tickets. **Do not purchase your dancer a ticket.** Everyone else using a seat must have a ticket. This includes toddlers. Children under 3 may sit on a parent's lap at no charge, but must have a purchased ticket if you wish for the toddler to have his or her own seat. As always, a portion of the ticket proceeds will go to charity. **Please purchase tickets in advance when possible to avoid confusion at the shows, and only purchase tickets you know you will need, as all show tickets are non-refundable.**

These volunteers sit with the dancers in the front of the auditorium and are responsible for bathroom trips; distribution/collection of props; and seeing that all dancers are picked up after the show. Lost & Found

June Show Costumes

- In mid to late November, dancers will be measured for costumes during their combination classes.
- Miss Janice orders costumes early, during the manufacturer's discounted price period, and passes those savings on to our dance families. This means, however, that costumes for the June Show must be ordered in January. **Therefore, all costume payments must be in the office before the studio closes on Dec. 15th.**
- Dancer's tights and finale T-shirt costs are included in the total costume cost. Sample T-shirt sizes will be available in the upstairs waiting room. (Not all sizes are available in our samples. Please size up or down as best as you can.)
- **During December Open House week (Dec. 10th - 15th), a responsible adult must be present to sign his or her agreement to the costume size to be ordered.** A manufacturer's size chart will be available, and parents may choose a different size other than the one recommended by Miss Janice. Please try on last year's costume and note the size. This will help you determine if you need to size up one or two sizes for this year's costume.
- Costumes will **not** be ordered without a parent's signature and full payment by Dec. 15th. Cash, check or credit card (*Visa, Master Charge or Discover*) will be accepted for costumes. Dancers may not perform without a costume.
- As stated in the welcome booklet received at registration, and the specialty class information received in May, students in Extra Tap, Extra Jazz and Special Ballet classes will incur fees for extra costumes. There will also be an additional guest choreographers fee for Extra Tap and Extra Jazz classes. Please remember to budget these additional expenses.
