Holiday Performances

- The Holiday Shows will be held December 12th at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. at the Cumberland Valley High School Performing Arts Center. Each combination class will perform a dance in one of the shows. Information was sent with your October Newsletter and is available on the web site.
- Performances are approximately 45 minutes long. All students are welcome to perform. (Please notify Miss Janice if your dancer is **NOT** planning to participate in the Holiday Show. Your dancer should still attend classes even if he or she is not participating.)
- Tickets are on sale in the studio office, during regular office hours, beginning November 1st. General admission tickets are \$5.00 if purchased before the show. The tickets will be \$8.00 at the door the day of the performances. Cash or check only will be accepted for tickets. **Do not purchase a ticket for your dancer.** Everyone else using a seat must have a ticket. This includes toddlers. Children under 3 may sit on a parent's lap at no charge, but must have a purchased ticket if you wish for the toddler to have his or her own seat. As always, a portion of the ticket proceeds will go to charity. **Please purchase tickets in advance when possible to avoid confusion at the shows, and only purchase tickets you will need, as all show tickets are non-refundable. Seating for this show is general admission.**

Dress Code

Since temperatures are dropping, we wanted to take this opportunity to remind you that dancers may wear turtlenecks under their leotards for extra warmth. Long sleeved leotards are available too.

Closings Due To Inclement Weather

- Call **691-5567** to hear a recorded message regarding closings. (Afternoon class cancellations will be available after 10:00 a.m.; evening class cancellations will be available after 3:00 p.m.) or check the website.
- Listen for make-up class times and dates, and make a note of them.
- If you hear a recording stating "we are currently on the other line," please call back later in order to hear the recording that lists the cancellations and make-up times.
- Closings will **not** be announced on TV, radio.
- The studio does **NOT** automatically close when schools do.

Due to the excessive number of calls we receive during inclement weather, we will be unable to return calls.



June Show Performance Packages

- In late November, dancers will be measured for costumes during their combination classes.
- Miss Janice orders costumes early, during the manufacturer's discounted price period, and passes those savings on to our dance families. This means, however, that costumes for the June Show must be ordered in December. **See the Tuition agreement for pay schedule.**
- The finale T-shirt costs are included in the performance package. Sample T-shirt sizes will be available in the upstairs waiting room.
- **During December Open House week (Dec. 4th - 10th), a responsible adult must be present to sign his or her agreement to the costume size to be ordered.** A manufacturer's size chart will be available, and parents may choose a different size other than the one recommended by Miss Janice. Please try on last year's costume and note the size. This will help you determine if you need to size up one or two sizes for this year's costume.
- Costumes will **not** be ordered without a parent's signature and partial payment. Cash, check or credit card (*Visa, Master Charge or Discover*) will be accepted for costumes. Dancers may not perform without a costume.
