All students should have the elastic straps on their ballet slippers sewn at this point in the dance season. If you are unsure how to sew your slippers, please see Miss Janice or the office staff.

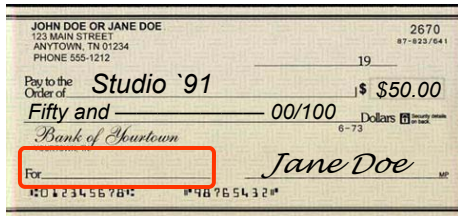


Never miss your \$10.00 Prompt Pay Discount again! Sign up for your monthly automatic credit card billing. Forms are available in the office.
